SALT IS SODIUM CHLORIDE it is a compound, Not a mixture NaCl = salt

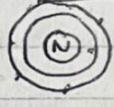
every atom in the universe, in order to stabilize it - meaning obey the laws of nature must have 8 electrons in the valence

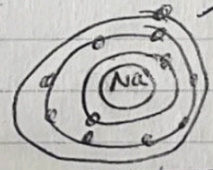
Sheep that stick close to the shephard are the least likely to walk away from the shephard and those on the outer edges are more likely to be influenced by atoms and mix with something else or become something else

In order to become stable, you need 8. which means 7+1=8

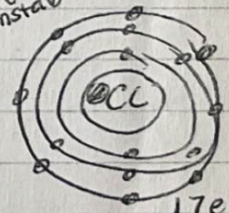
2 faith = 1 LORD = 1 Baptism = 1 + 7
