In Hebrew, all letters had corresponding #'s. We will prove it with chemistry. For example on bridges they would find gravings saying things like "I love the woman whose name is 587" because they would match to a number - this is called "Gematria". For example in the Bible the #8 is the number of hearing, and to hear, means to obey/harken in the Bible. To be "severed" is to be fully baptized in Christ. Baptism is not the ritual of water. It is blood. It means to die daily. To get rid of your "outer man" which is self & the carnal desires of this world & to be severed. (8) is a very important # in the Bible.

SALT IS SODIUM CHLORIDE *it is a compound
Not a mixture* $\text{NaCl} = \text{Salt}$

every atom in the universe, in order to stabilize it - meaning obey the laws of nature must have (8) electrons in the valence

The nucleus, the center of the structure is the most dense, where pretty much all the matter resides there, everything else in the world is empty space - or vain - vanity = doesn't matter - empty

A compound is when 2 substances are no longer what they used to be. It is a new creation

Salomon says how he had all the workers and riches in the world, but it was all van and vexation of spirit

This means the universe is mostly nothing which is backed by science meaning it meant nothing

You can read that in Ecc. or psalm 62:9



Electrons are ALL the same. The only thing that makes them different is WHAT THEY BOND WITH. This means that "Dung or Diamonds" its all the same. God decides if you will be dung or diamonds

All electrons are known to have 7 shells

In Jewish culture salt was put on dung hills so it wouldn't stink - phil 3:8

Salt preserves, cuts, heals

The 7 things you need to add to grow your faith and become mature. (It doesn't happen overnight)

2 peter 2:5-7 tells us what 7 things we need to become stable

Poison = the baptism we must go through which is fiery trials.

Matt 5:13

"... if the salt lost its ~~savour~~ ^{Savour"}

Savour is μόραινο in Greek, it's a verb!

→ root word is μόρος (where we get the word)
moron

This word means to make
foolish
tasteless, useless,

when we tell the truth about God we appear foolish to those
who don't understand, not pre-ordained vessels of wrath, etc

to be foolish is GOOD in God's eyes. Because you aren't telling
the true word of God if people don't call you a fool, because
they are simple minded & useless and cannot receive it. Therefore, to
them, you look like the fool. Therefore God says fool is good

Check these verses out about how God says foolish is good. It
means your telling the truth because people won't believe you or
hear or understand
